Afghan Emergency Resettlement Category Application for Residence

The Afghan Emergency Resettlement Category is a special permanent resident visa available to Afghan citizens who were assisted, by the New Zealand Government, to evacuate from Afghanistan to New Zealand for the purpose of resettlement in New Zealand.

This form can be used by someone applying for a permanent resident visa under this special category, including someone that already holds a resident visa.

Requirements

You must meet all of the following requirements:

- · be a citizen of Afghanistan
- have been in Afghanistan on 15 August 2021
- have entered New Zealand on or after 16 August 2021
- be in New Zealand when you make the application
- be of good character.

You must also meet one of the following three criteria when you entered New Zealand:

1. Held a Critical Purpose Visitor Visa on the basis of assisting a New Zealand Government agency in Afghanistan

People who assisted a New Zealand Government agency in Afghanistan were able to make a request to New Zealand's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT) to be resettled in New Zealand. A Critical Purpose Visitor Visa was granted by Immigration New Zealand where it was verified that the person did assist a New Zealand Government agency in Afghanistan, and the person or their immediate family were at risk as a result of their association to New Zealand. Visas were also granted to partners and dependent children of these people. If you held one of these Critical Purpose Visitor Visas when you entered New Zealand, then you may be eligible for a permanent resident visa under this category.

2. Held a Critical Purpose Visitor Visa that was granted between 15 August and 12 September 2021

If you were granted a Critical Purpose Visitor Visa between 15 August 2021 and 12 September 2021 (inclusive), then you may be eligible for a permanent resident visa under this category. The Critical Purpose Visitor Visa may have been granted for any reason, it does not have to be the result of assistance provided to a New Zealand Government agency. You must have held the Critical Purpose Visitor Visa when you entered New Zealand.

3. Travelled to New Zealand by 12 September 2021

If you travelled to New Zealand before 12 September 2021, then you may be eligible for a permanent resident visa under this category. It doesn't matter what type of visa you held when you entered New Zealand, or when that visa was granted.

Partners and dependent children

You can include your partner and any dependent child(ren) in your application. They must also meet the requirements outlined above, but we will not carry out character checks for children under the age of 17.



A partner is someone you are:

- · legally married to,
- in a civil union partnership with, or
- · in a de facto relationship with.

A dependent child is someone who is:

- · your or your partner's biological or adopted child,
- · less than 25 years old, and
- totally or substantially reliant on you or your partner for financial support.

A child who is financially independent is still a dependent child if they are:

- 17 years old or younger, and single, or
- 18, 19 or 20 years old, single, and with no children of their own.

Immigration Advisers Licensing Act 2007

Under the Immigration Advisers Licensing Act 2007, it is an offence to provide immigration advice without being licensed or exempt. If your immigration adviser is not licensed when they should be, Immigration New Zealand will return your application.
